offers Food Handlers Class***

Preston – Southeastern District Health Department (SDHD) will be offering a Food Handlers class on September 10, 2007, from 4:00 p.m. until 7 p.m. at the Franklin County Office, 42 West St. South in Preston.

The newly adopted food code requires there to be a person in charge on duty at all times who is familiar with the safe handling and service of food. One of the most effective and highly acclaimed ways to meet this requirement is the “Food Class” offered by SDHD. The course has been updated to teach all the changes in the new food rules. The course runs for three hours and all pertinent information on food protection and safety is presented.

At the end of the course, participants will be required to take an exam and must score 70% or better to pass. The cost of the course is \$10 per person and we ask that you pre-pay and pre-register, as seating is limited.
