

# Pastoral Counseling for Youth Depression and Suicide

This training will address issues related to depression and suicide among Idaho's youth and will provide clergy with information on topics related to prevention and postvention. Such topics include talking with youth about depression and suicide, family comfort and community support after a suicide, and guidelines for eulogies. The SPAN Idaho Suicide Prevention Tool Kit will also be presented.

This is a two-hour training conducted by The Suicide Prevention Action Network of Idaho (SPAN Idaho). There will be seven such trainings throughout the state. The trainings are sponsored by Youth Suicide Prevention Services at Idaho State University.
