Arthritis Foundation Self-Help Class

Pocatello – The Southeastern District Health Department (SDHD) and the Arthritis Foundation announce a 6-week Arthritis Foundation Self-Help class to be held in Pocatello June 5 through July 10, 2007 for people who have arthritis. The classes will be held on Tuesdays from 4:30 p.m. -6:00 p.m. at the Southeastern District Health Department, located at 1901 Alvin Ricken Drive. The cost for the six week session is \$30.00.

This group education program helps people who have arthritis learn the skills they need to build their own self-management program that helps them become an active member of their healthcare team, work better with their healthcare providers, and handle their day-to-day challenges of their disease. The Arthritis Foundation Self-Help Program is designed to complement the care provided by a healthcare team and allows people who have arthritis to share their experiences with other people who are also dealing with arthritis.
